The Dance Education Association of the Philippines (DEAP), Inc. and the Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP) will conduct the *28th National Annual Dance Convention-Workshop* with the theme *DEAP-PUP Unwavering Commitment to the Dissemination and Preservation of Filipino Cultural Heritage* on May 15-18, 2013 at the PUP, Sta. Mesa, Manila.

The Program aims to:
