The National Association for Early Childhood Education (NAECE) will conduct its *National Conference* with the theme *Helping Teacher and Parents Cope with the Challenges in the K-3 New Early Childhood Curriculum* on April 18-20, 2013 at the Vibal Publishing House Auditorium, Araneta Avenue, Quezon City.

The main objective of the conference is to help teacher-child advocates cope with the challenges of the K-3 in the new early childhood curriculum.

The topics to be discussed are the following:

1. Mother Tongue-Based-Multilingual Education (MTB-MLE) Enhancing Children's Learning;
2. Enhancing Curriculum Through the Use of Indigenous Materials;
3. Behavior Management;
4. Issues on Values; and
5. Building a Community of Practice K-3.
