METRO MANILA FILM FESTIVAL (MMFF) CINEPHONE COMPETITION 2013

The Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), through the Metro Manila Film Festival (MMFF)-Philippines will hold the *MMFF Cinephone Competition 2013*.

The Competition aims to recognize and expose the participants' creativity and talents in story telling or in expressing their ideas through the use of an accessible and affordable medium like the built-in video cameras of their mobile phones.

This activity is open to all Filipino high schools and college students nationwide.

The rules of the Competition are as follows:

1. Each entry may be entered by an individual or a group of no more than five students;
2. All members of the Production Team must be officially enrolled in a school/university with good moral standing. The Department Head/Dean/Principal must endorse the participants to the competition;
3. Group entries shall have one designated official representative;
4. There is no limit as to the number of entries per school/college/university; and
5. There shall be no inter-school collaboration for any entry.

The entry requirements are as follows:

1. Duly accomplished entry form (Form A);
2. Three-copies of one page synopsis/sequence treatment of the story (no more than 300 words) (Form B); and
3. Endorsement from the Head of the Department/Dean/Principal (Form C).

All entry requirements must be submitted through mail or personal delivery to the MMFF Secretariat at the Office of the Chairman, EDSA corner Orense St., Guadalupe Nuevo, Makati City or through email (scanned copies) to [filmfest25@yahoo.com](mailto:filmfest25@yahoo.com) on or before *August 16, 2013*.

Email submissions shall be sent in the form of attachments of scanned copies of all duly accomplished requirements. An entry will only be considered submitted if official email confirmation is received from the MMFF Secretariat.

The 20 entries (ten from high school and ten from college) shall be selected, each from Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao with a total of 60 selected stories.

Accepted scripts shall be announced two weeks after the deadline of submission.
