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65TH ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE HOME ECONOMICS

The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA) will hold its *65th Annual Convention* with the theme *Home Economics Literacy: Investing in Our Future* on October 25-27, 2013 at the Camarines Sur Water Sports Complex, Capitol Complex, Cadlan Pili, Camarines Sur.

The Convention aims to:

1. understand the philosophy and rationale of an enhanced, structured and re-focused Home Economics Curriculum;
2. develop the capabilities/competencies of teachers in Technology and Home Economics;
3. renew commitment and partnership with stakeholders in molding the future of the youth through the development of life-long skills; and
