INTERNATIONAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT SUMMIT 2013

The National Association of UNESCO Clubs in the Philippines (NAUCP), Inc. in partnership with the UNESCO National Commission of the Philippines and the Local Government of Taguig will conduct the *International Youth Development (IYD) Summit 2013* with the theme *My Philippines, Beyond 2015: Vision, Inspiration, Transformation* on September 27-29, 2013 at the NBC Tent, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City.

The Summit aims to:

1. deepen the participants' awareness concerning the progress of the Millenium Development Goals (MDGs) beyond 2015;
2. develop a clear understanding on the role of the youth and educators in pursuing the UNESCO's mission and vision at the grassroots level;
3. promote volunteerism as a tool for poverty eradication by showcasing best practices in implementing the MDG-related projects; and
4. increase the membership of NAUCP in the Philippines by orienting the participants about UNESCO, UNESCO Clubs accreditation procedures and the benefits of becoming an accredited UNESCO Club.

Youth leaders, elementary and secondary school teachers from both public and private schools, academe, and local government unit (LGU), employment practitioners are invited to attend this activity.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
