SECOND PHILIPPINE PROFESSIONAL SUMMIT

The Philippine Association of Professional Regulatory Board (PAPRB), in cooperation with the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) will hold its *Second Philippine Professional Summit* with the theme *Empowering Professionals Towards ASEAN Economic Community 2015* on October 15-16, 2013 at the Fiesta Pavilion, Manila Hotel, City of Manila. The PAPRB is composed of incumbent and past chairpersons, vice chairpersons and members of the Philippine Regulation Boards (PRBs) under the administration, control and supervision of the PRC.
