FIRST INTERNATIONAL YOUTH AND EDUCATORS SUMMIT (I-YES)
FOR TRANSFORMATIVE EDUCATION

The Philippine Normal University (PNU)-Center for Transformative Education, PNU Foundation, Inc. and the Asian Network of Youth Volunteers (ANYV) will conduct the *First International Youth and Educators Summit (I-YES) for Transformative Education* with the theme *Mainstreaming Transformative Education in Post Rights-Based Development Agenda* on December 9-12, 2013 at the Eurotel-Boracay, Station 2, Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan.
