ASSISTANCE TO TYPHOON YOLANDA VICTIMS: RUN-FOR-A-CAUSE, DUBBED
AS *TAKBO PARA SA BUHAY, TAKBO PARA SA BAHAY* OR REBUILD LIVES,
REBUILD HOMES, REBUILD COMMUNITIES

The National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC) has tied up with the Habitat for Humanity Philippines to spearhead a campaign to be kicked-off in a run-for-a-cause dubbed as *Takbo para sa Buhay, Takbo para sa Bahay* or Rebuild Lives, Rebuild Homes, Rebuild Communities in which concrete assistance could be provided to the victims of the Super Typhoon Yolanda. The Campaign will be held on November 24, 2013, Sunday from 5:30-8:30 a.m. at the Quezon Memorial Circle and Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City.

The Campaign aims to:

1. generate support to a campaign for providing immediate emergency shelter kits for the typhoon victims;
2. help them reconstruct homes and settlements in poor areas in the near term; and
3. develop and popularize a reconstruction model hinged on people participation, climate change resiliency and employment guarantees for the victims.
