SEARCH FOR THE AWARDEE OF THE 2013 SACEDA YOUTH LEAD (SYL)  
MOST INSPIRING TEACHER OF THE PHILIPPINES

The Saceda Youth Lead (SYL) announces the Search for the Awardee of the *2013 SYL Most Inspiring Teacher of the Philippines*. The theme of this activity is *Through Our Teachers We See the Future of the Country and Through Their Good Deeds They Prosper as a Nation*. The awarding will be held on December 6, 2013 at the Saceda Youth Lead (SYL) Center, Dumaguete City.

The Search for the awardee is based on the following:

1. Must be in service for the past 5 to 10 years with the Department of Education (DepEd) or any academic institution in the Philippines;
2. Must have participated in at least one of the Saceda Youth Lead (SYL) programs, nationally or internationally;
3. Must have paved the way for SYL Programs and Initiative to be conducted at the school, district, division and regional levels;
4. Must have exemplified the core values of SYL and competencies and have generously shared skills and values for the development of the self, family and nation;
5. Must be effective and creative in managing the arts and craft of teaching and student development. The teacher is enthusiastic, well prepared for class, and inspire both students and teachers to become better and responsible citizens, and have the ability to encourage and motivate learning in students through various leadership activities and initiatives. They are open to new techniques and approaches to stimulate intellectual growth and generate active teacher and student participation; and
6. Must have made an impact to the lives of students and teachers, promoting excellence, leadership development, peace and mutual understanding.

The target participants to this Search are 21 teacher-nominees who go beyond classroom work, who exhibit excellence in skills and values development and transcend it to their students by empowering them through various initiatives.

The nominees will converge in Dumaguete City on *December 5-6, 2013* for evaluation and training. The formal Awarding Ceremony will be held on *December 6, 2013* at 6:00 a.m.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
