Archaeology Workshop	March 17, 2014	The workshop will share with the participants the importance of Archaeology in discovering the way people had lived in the past and how these findings put contemporary societies on equal footing
<i>Cantunan</i>	March 13, 2014	A <i>pancit</i> competition will be held to put into test the participants to eat as many hot and spicy <i>pancit</i> canton as they can
High School Orientation	February 17 and 24, 2014 (one Public School and one Private School)	The career orientation is organized to cater to the interest of the high school students in Metro Manila in order to help them broaden their horizons in choosing the field as their promising career paths which serve as a bacon to bring about a perspective-changing life
Quizmiz	March 6, 2014	A Quiz Bee will be held with questions which are fundamental to the discipline of Anthropology. It will raise the consciousness of students about Anthropology and its applications
Culmination Night	March 21, 2014	A night with current and past members to get together and reminisce moments of the organization being in its 50 th Anniversary
