29TH ANNUAL NATIONAL DANCE EDUCATORS CONVENTION-WORKSHOP

The Dance Education Association of the Philippines (DEAP), Inc. will conduct the *29th Annual National Dance Educators Convention-Workshop* with the theme *DEAP: Its Continuing Leadership Through Innovations and Challenges in Dance Education* from April 25 to 29, 2014 at the Alipio Fernandez Sr. People's Astrodome, Dagupan City.
