CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR MUSIC TEACHERS (CEMT) OF THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (UP) COLLEGE OF MUSIC

The University of the Philippines (UP) College of Music announces its Extension Program, *the Continuing Education for Music Teachers (CEMT)* which is a post baccalaureate certificate program to be completed in three summers.

It is designed to address the need for music teachers to enhance their musical growth and teaching competencies. Such growth will have an impact in the quality of music teaching and learning across the country. A certificate of completion will be given at the end of the program to participants who have completed the three levels of training.

At the end of the program, the participants will be able to:

1. demonstrate a thorough understanding of the principles of music theory, practice, and pedagogy;
2. apply their musical and pedagogical knowledge and skills in solo and group, rehearsal, performance, and in general music classroom experience; and
3. show their appreciation of varied music teaching and learning situations, as well as of diverse forms of music-making and music cultures in the Philippines and the world.

The enrolment period will be on April 21, 2014. Classes will start on April 28-30; May 2-3 (first week); May 5-9; May 12-16, and May 19-23 (last week).

The Certificate Program is open to all music teachers from both public and private schools.
