GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN DEMOGRAPHY AND POPULATION STUDIES

The University of the Philippines Population Institute (UPPI), College of Social Sciences and Philosophy announces its graduate programs. Under these programs, the student may pursue a degree leading to Master of Arts in Demography (M.A. Demography) or the Master in Population Studies (MPopS).

As an academic unit, UPPI performs the three-pronged function of teaching, research, and extension. Through its links with the government, local, and international agencies, it plays an important role in the analysis of population-related issues by way of a strong program of research and extension backed by facilities for analysis of survey data and data archive of surveys on population-related topics.

To qualify for the program, a student must have completed a baccalaureate degree from a recognized college or university with a General Weighted Average of 2.0 (or its equivalent) or better. Computer literacy and a good background in the Social Sciences, Mathematics, or Statistics are additional requirements for applicants to the program. The applicant must also pass the Admission Test given by the Institute.

The target applicants are teachers and administrators from both public and private schools.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
