SOUTHEAST ASIAN MINISTERS OF EDUCATION ORGANIZATION (SEAMEO) CONGRESS

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO) Secretariat, the British Council and the Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology (IPST) Thailand will jointly conduct the SEAMEO Congress with the theme *Southeast Asia in Transition: Re-Thinking Education Science and Culture for Regional Integration* from October 21 to 22, 2014 at the Imperial Queen's Park Hotel, Bangkok, Thailand.

The Congress aims to: (1) explore new avenues for managing the diverse changes in education, science and culture; and (2) enhance regional understanding and cooperation among the participants in Southeast Asia and beyond. Specifically, its objectives are the following:

1. to draw from academic, industry and international experiences on realistic, implementable education and human resource development (HRD) policies and practices;
2. to trigger further investigations on education policy and capacity-building issues relevant for integration and cooperation in Southeast Asia; and
3. to give impetus for the establishment and renewing of cooperation among education institutions, industry and regional/international organizations in the advancement of HRD in the region.

The deadline for submission of abstracts of proposal papers is on or before *May 31, 2014*.

The target participants are educators and different stakeholders from the Southeast Asia.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
