METRO MANILA FILM FESTIVAL (MMFF) CINEPHONE COMPETITION 2014

The Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), through the Metro Manila Film Festival (MMFF)-Philippines will hold the *MMFF Cinephone Competition 2014*.

The Competition aims to recognize and expose the participants' creativity and talents in story telling or in expressing their ideas through the use of accessible and affordable mobile phones.

This Competition is open to all Filipino high school and college students nationwide.

The rules of the Competition are as follows:

1. All members of the Production Team must be officially enrolled in the same school. Inter-school collaboration for any entry is not allowed. There is no limit as to the number of entries per school;
2. The video shall be completely shot through the use of any camera phone. There is no limit as to the number of cameras to be used in the duration of the video;
3. The video length shall be maximum of three minutes;
4. Videos may be edited through any editing methods;
5. Music used in any entry must be original;
6. The MMFF reserves the right to create, revoke, and modify at any time, in any way its entry requirements, rules and regulations at its absolute discretion without prior notice;
7. The MMFF will not be liable for any loss, damage to property, or harm that may befall the participants during the production of the video; and
8. All video entries shall remain with, and become the property of the MMFF.

The entry requirements are as follows:

1. Duly accomplished entry form;
2. Proof of enrolment in the current semester and school year;
3. At least five "behind the scenes" pictures of the production team filming the video with a camera phone;
4. Detailed filmography; and
5. Written consent from the actors/actresses involved.

All entry requirements must be submitted through email or personal delivery to the MMFF Secretariat at the Office of the Chairman, Main Building EDSA corner Orense St., Guadalupe Nuevo, Makati City and the completed videos must be uploaded online on or before *October 4, 2014*.
