NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM

The Association of Educators for Interrelated Research and Studies (AEIRS) will hold the *National Seminar-Workshop on Campus Journalism* with the theme *Retooling the Techniques of Journalistic Writing: A Requisite for Good and Ideal School Paper* from September 12 to 14, 2014 at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

The Seminar aims to:

1. prepare campus journalists to meet the qualities of a good written report in the areas of News, Feature, Sports, Editorial;
2. put into practice the latest trends in Layout Designing (Layouting) and Cartooning;
3. give life and color to the school paper; and
4. propose or present school paper for critiquing and evaluation.

The target participants are school administrators, supervisors, principals, head teachers, coordinators, instructors/professors, editors-in-chief or staff members of a school paper, teachers from both public and private schools.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
