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FIRST TRAINING PROGRAM FOR HOME ECONOMICS (HE), TECHNOLOGY  
AND LIVELIHOOD EDUCATION (TLE), AND *EDUKASYONG PANTAHANAN*  
*AT PANGKABUHAYAN* (EPP)

The Council of Deans and Heads in Home Economics and Livelihood Education of the Philippines (CODHHELEP) Inc. will hold its *First Training Program for Home Economics (HE), Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE), and Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP)* with the theme *Home Economics and Livelihood Education: Fostering a Culture of Excellence* from October 22 to 25, 2014 at the Aklan State University, Banga, Aklan.

The Training Program aims to:

1. provide the teacher-participants with a venue for sharing updates, issues and concerns;
2. encourage them to learn new and appropriate teaching strategies; and
3. update them with Outcomes-Based Education and how it could be successfully applied/implemented in the K to 12 Technology and Livelihood Curriculum.

The target participants are teachers of Home Economics (HE), Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE), and *Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan* (EPP) from both public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
