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2014 NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUB MONTH (NSCM) CELEBRATION  
CUM SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR SCIENCE EDUCATORS

Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 28 dated September 2, 1986 and Presidential Proclamation No. 24 dated September 23, 2002 declaring September as the National Science Club Month (NSCM), the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP) will hold the culminating activity of the *2014 National Science Club Month (NSCM) Celebration Cum Seminar-Workshop for Science Educators* with the theme *Strengthening Innovation for the Reformed Curriculum* from September 27 to 30, 2014 at the Grand Men Seng Hotel, Davao City.

The Celebration cum Seminar-Workshop aims to:

1. assess programs and projects implemented in connection with the celebration of the NSCM;
2. strengthen the innovations made for the reformed curriculum;
3. develop knowledge and skills of Science mentors for them to demonstrate quality instructions using innovations in teaching in terms of strategies;
4. conduct a demonstration lesson using the innovations made for the reformed curriculum and appropriately apply them in real-life situations; and
5. give recognition to the outstanding accomplishments of Science advisers and science educators.

The science club advisers, science teachers, department heads, science coordinators, school principals, administrators, district/division/regional supervisors and science enthusiasts from both public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide are invited to attend the NSCM Celebration cum seminar-workshop for science educators.

Activities during the Seminar-Workshop include plenary sessions, workshop, group dynamics, and interactive sessions. There will be presentations of projects and activities, including best practices and achievements, of each regional science club.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
