ANNUAL PROGRAMME OF THE SEAMEO REGIONAL CENTRE
FOR HISTORY AND TRADITION

The SEAMEO Regional Centre for History and Tradition (CHAT) will hold its *Annual Programme* entitled *Myanmar History from Myanmar Perspectives* from November 12 to 18, 2014.

The programme consists of a series of lectures and discussions conducted by prominent Myanmar scholars and a five-day trip to the historical cities of Bago, Mandalay and Bagan.

The lecture topics are the following:

1. Myanmar Historical Background;
2. Ancient Pyu Cities in Myanmar;
3. Bagan: Art and Architecture;
4. Hanthawaddy: Maritime Trade and Land Empire;
5. Mandalay: The Court and the City; and
6. History of Yangon.
