2014 SEMINAR-WORKSHOP OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF SCIENCE
TEACHERS AND EDUCATORS (NOSTE)

The National Organization of Science Teachers and Educators (NOSTE) will hold its *2014 Seminar-Workshop* with the theme *Natural Disaster: Mitigation and Preparedness for Science Teachers* from September 26 to 28, 2014 at the West Visayas State University, Center for Research and Innovations in Science and Mathematics Education, La Paz, Iloilo City.

The Seminar-Workshop aims to:

1. increase knowledge and understanding of identified natural phenomena (earth's crust movements and weather phenomena) causing disasters among humans and other living things;
2. observe through examples and shared presentations the different mitigation and preparedness measures necessary for teachers in the school and community;
3. conceptualize investigatory activities for science learners and enthusiasts; and
4. broaden insights on the role of science teachers in addressing natural disasters as learning episodes in science classrooms.

The target participants are science teachers from both public and private elementary and secondary schools, science educators, researchers in science and science-related fields, advocates and champions of Disaster Risk Reduction and Mitigation.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
