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2014 ANNUAL NATIONAL SEARCHES AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS
ON *EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO* (EsP)/VALUES EDUCATION

Ang Pambansang Samahan Para sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga (PSEP) Inc. will hold its *2014 Annual National Searches and National Competitions on Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP)/Values Education* from November 28 to 30, 2014 at the Hotel Supreme and Convention Plaza, Magsaysay, Baguio City. The details of the National Searches and Competitions are as follows:

Search/Competition	Aim	Participant
National Search for Outstanding School-Based EsP/Values Education Program	To recognize the outstanding achievements and efforts of schools and institutions in sustaining and strengthening the EsP/Values Education Program	The Search is open to both public and private elementary and secondary schools, duly nominated by their respective region/division/district head using the prescribed nomination form.
National Search for Outstanding EsP/Values Education Teacher	To recognize the outstanding achievements of EsP/Values Education teachers and to encourage others in the field to uplift the quality of teaching values in the country	The Search is open to all full-time EsP/Values Education teachers from both public and private schools, duly nominated by their respective school heads (SHs) using the prescribed nomination form.
<i>Tagis Talino</i> (Secondary Level)	To recognize the winners of the <i>Tagis Talino</i> , On-the-Spot Poster-Making Contest, and <i>Sayawit</i>	Top five competing teams comprising high school students during the regional level competition
On-the-Spot Poster-Making Contest (Elementary and Secondary Levels)		Top five participants, Grades 4-6 pupils and high school students, during the regional level competition
<i>Sayawit</i> (Elementary and Secondary Levels)		Top five performing groups comprising Grades 4-6 pupils and high school students during the regional level competition

In the absence of regional/division/district level eliminations, the schools may directly participate in the national level competitions.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
