CALL FOR APPLICATIONS OF THE KENNEDY-LUGAR YOUTH EXCHANGE
AND STUDY (K-L YES) PROGRAM 2015-2016

The American Field Service-Intercultural Programs Philippines (AFS-IPP) announces the opening of applications for the next cycle of *Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange and Study (K-L YES) Program 2015-2016*.

The Program aims to:

1. promote a better understanding among youth from selected Youth Exchange and Study (YES) countries about American society, people, institutions, and culture;
2. foster lasting personal ties;
3. increase the capacity of organizations in participating countries to engage the exchange participants in activities which promote mutual understanding, respect for diversity, leadership skills, and an understanding of civil society during their exchange in the United States (US); and
4. enhance Americans' understanding of foreign students' countries and cultures.

The K-L YES Program offers full scholarship to high school students, including students with physical disabilities.

This program is funded by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs-US Department of State, in partnership with lead grantee American Councils for International Education and AFS-USA consortium.
