THIRD PHILIPPINE PROFESSIONAL SUMMIT

The Philippine Association of the Professional Regulatory Board (PAPRB) Members Inc., in cooperation with the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) will hold its *Third Philippine Professional Summit* with the theme *Ensuring International Alignment of Education and Professional Practice* from October 16 to 17, 2014 at the Fiesta Pavilion, Manila Hotel.

This activity is in celebration of the Philippine Professionals Competitiveness Week in October which is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 487.

At the end of the Summit, the participants should be able to:

1. perform a situational analysis of their own cluster and individual profession/s;
2. understand and apply the concept and principle of international alignment at the level of education, professional practice and at the level of national qualifications frameworks;
3. discuss the most critical areas of non-alignment using the ASEAN-member countries and the major countries of destination of Filipino professionals for comparison;
4. formulate an Action Agenda addressing the gaps/weaknesses;
5. discuss innovative programs which can be adopted by professionals;
and
6. identify next steps and activities of the association.

The target participants are all local and overseas Filipino professionals, officers and members of the Accredited Professional Organizations (APOs) and its stakeholders (national, local and international chapters), professionals in the government and private sectors, registered and licensed professionals under PRC, professionals in firms registered with PRC with temporary/special permits (TSPs), continuing professional development providers, training program providers, and professionals in institutions offering academic courses for the regulated professions.

This activity shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
