11TH NATIONAL ROVER MOOT

The Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will hold its *11th National Rover Moot* from October 23 to 29, 2014 in Zamboanga del Sur, Pagadian City.

The Rover Moot aims to:

1. instill the value of autonomy and a sense of social responsibility among Rover Scouts;
2. prepare Rover Scouts in performing services needed by barangays and communities, especially on environmental education and action to help save Mother Earth;
3. improve leadership skills and ability to work as a team; and
4. appreciate the cultural and historical heritage of the host municipality/province.

Unique activities are lined-up for this event, which are focused mainly on leadership, community development, environmental awareness and action, and fellowship.

The target participants in this national scouting event are rovers, roverettes, scouts, scouters and school officials as well as representatives from other Scout Associations in the Asia Pacific Region.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
