SCREENING OF THE FILM *SINE PANITIK*

The Film Academy of the Philippines (FAP), through the support of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) and the Film Development Council of the Philippines (FDCP), invites concerned learners, teachers and parents to the screening of the film *Sine Panitik* starting next month in schools and in theaters nationwide. Showing in schools is *free* of charge; screening in theaters is *voluntary*.

The screening of the film aims to:

1. provide the learner-viewers with Filipino literature such as short stories, plays, novels, poetry, folk tales and short films to generate better understanding of and deeper appreciation for literature-based film; and
2. provide the schools with a video library of literature materials for pupils/ students.

Tres Sine Panitik, a Trilogy that will include three short stories, is the first in a series of films which are translated into film classic literary masterpieces written by Filipino writers, and adapted into screenplays during the first *Sine Panitik* Scriptwriting Contest last year.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*. This activity is also subject to the *no-collection policy* as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, *An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law)*.
