OF SCIENCE (KINETICS)

The Physics Society of Adamson University (PSAU), in partnership with the Adamson University Physics Department and *Samahang Mag-aaral sa Pagpapaunlad ng Pisika (SMPP)*, will conduct its organizational-related event dubbed as *Knowing the Key in Nurturing and Empowering the Technical and Intellectual Capabilities of Students in the Field of Science (KINETICS)* on January 24, 2015 at the Adamson University Grounds, 900 San Marcelino Street, Ermita, Manila.

The Event aims to:

1. expose the competence of the youth participating in developing their mental capability especially in the field of Physics;
2. emphasize its significance as a basic Science in nation building;
3. aid in instilling insights in the hearts and minds of the participants in the contributions of Physics in their daily lives; and
4. develop self-confidence and camaraderie between the participating youth and mentors by having a meaningful intellectual interaction.
