13TH NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP IN HISTORIOGRAPHY AND THE SOCIAL SCIENCES
OF THE *BAGONG KASAYSAYAN (BAKAS) INC.*

The *Bagong Kasaysayan (BAKAS) Inc. - Bahay Saliksikan sa Kasaysayan*, in partnership with the Sacred Heart of Jesus Holdings, the City Government of Roxas, the Provincial Government of Capiz, Capiz Historical and Cultural Society and Filamer Christian University, will hold its *13th National Seminar-Workshop in Historiography and the Social Sciences* with the theme *Panahon ng Transisyon at Krisis ng Lipunan at Kalinangan ng Kapilipinuhan (1890-1913): Huling Baytang ng Pagkabuo ng Bayan (1588-1913). Ang Pangalawang Bahagi ng Kasaysayan ng Kapilipinuhan (500,000/250,000 BK-2015 MK)* from April 22 to 25, 2015 at the following venues in Roxas City:

The Seminar-Workshop aims to:

1. explain to the participants the period of transition and crisis in Philippine society from 1890 up to 1913, the last part of the second period in *Kasaysayan ng Kapilipinuhan: Pagkabuo ng Bayan (1588-1913)*. This period follows *Pamayanan (500,000/250,000 BK – 1588 MK)*;
2. show to them the problems of Philippine state and society this past century since 1914 could be traced to this period of transition and crisis;
3. advance/promote, as with other works of *BAKAS Inc. - Bahay Saliksikan sa Kasaysayan, Pantayo* Historiography, Filipino language and national unity as it relates to the substance of the period 1890-1913; and
4. contribute to an understanding of local histories, particularly that of Roxas City and the Province of Capiz, and how these fall within the strand of national historical and cultural development.

The target participants are the teachers, professors and educators from both public and private elementary and secondary schools.
