| Climate Change: What Future Are We Facing? | This show entertains and educates the viewers with an easy-to-understand story about the changing climate in planet Earth. The viewer experiences a spectacular environment as he/she creates landscapes and virtual scenes. |
| 3D Film Showing • Under the Sea 3D • Forest Hero: Coni for younger pupils and students | The film <i>Under the Sea</i> provides the viewers with a visually stunning footage without disregarding the fact that they are being educated about the damaging effects of climate change in the ocean. The film <i>Forest Hero: Coni</i> is an animation that is all about the harmful effects of Climate Change and Global Warming to the environment. |
| Interactive Exhibit on Renewable Resources | This activity gives the pupil/student a vivid display of the some of the leading examples of alternative renewable energy resources. It demonstrates the mechanics of generating green energy and enables the students to understand that even in the realm alternative energy there is no single solution but a cautious crafted combination of different approaches. |
