RESEARCH PROJECT ON READINESS OF SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE PHILIPPINES  
IN OFFERING COMMUNICATION AND MEDIA RELATED COURSES AS PART  
OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE K TO 12 PROGRAM

The Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP), through its Department of Journalism, College of Communication, will conduct a research project on the *Readiness of Secondary Schools in the Philippines Offering Communication and Media Related Courses as Part of the Implementation of the K to 12 Program*.

The objective of this Research Project is to help the Department of Education (DepEd), as well as the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), and other stakeholders in identifying the competencies and needs of high school teachers handling journalism and other media related courses from different secondary schools in the Philippines. Specifically, it aims to develop a nationwide teacher readiness study to measure the preparedness of teachers and various secondary schools in teaching communication and media related courses which require technical and theoretical requirements in the mode and delivery.

The research will utilize a descriptive design, wherein survey and series of focused group discussions (FDGs) will be conducted among target respondents and participants. The respondent schools will be selected through clustered/random sampling. The 16 regions will be grouped into six clusters wherein public and private schools will be selected randomly by classification. Each region will be represented by two schools (one public and one private).

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
