17TH NATIONAL EDUCATOR'S COOPERATIVE SUMMIT (NECS) AND GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE PHILIPPINE FEDERATION OF TEACHERS
AND EMPLOYEES COOPERATIVES (PFTEC)

The Philippine Federation of Teachers and Employees Cooperatives (PFTEC) will conduct its *17th National Educators Cooperative Summit (NECS) and Annual General Assembly* with the theme *Put Teachers at the Heart of Coop Economy, Your Passport to Security* from May 14 to 15, 2015 at the Conflate Events Place, 4th Floor, La Azotea Bldg., Session Road, Baguio City.

These annual activities bring together the cooperative officers and DepEd officials and educators in promoting a common understanding of the fundamentals of cooperatives among coop members, officers and management staff, officials of the DepEd. Specifically, the summit will enable participants to level up with the ICA Cooperative Blueprint – the “2020 Vision” is for the cooperative form of business by 2020 to become:

1. The acknowledged leader in economic, social, and environmental sustainability;
2. The model preferred by people; and
3. The fastest growing form of enterprise.

Following the focal strategic plan of the 2020 vision, Cooperative Identity will be the focus of this year's forum. The objective is to develop the external identity and it aims to build the cooperative message and secure the cooperative identity.

The target participants are the cooperative officers and members (board of directors, audit committee, election committee, general manager, treasurer, and secretary) from the bureau/department in-charge of cooperative programs, cooperative coordinators in DepEd, school administrators, (teachers-in-charge, head teachers, principals), supervisors, assistant schools division superintendents, schools divisions superintendents, assistant regional directors and regional directors.
