INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON THE PACIFIC WAR IN THE PHILIPPINES

In commemoration of the 70th Anniversary of the End of the Pacific War in the Philippines, the University of the Philippines (UP) Department of History, and the Third World Studies Center of the Colleges of Social Sciences and Philosophy will hold the *International Conference on the Pacific War in the Philippines* with the theme *Occupation and Liberation* from September 3 to 5, 2015 at the GT-Toyota Auditorium, Asian Center, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City.

The Conference aims to:

1. underscore the role of human agency in the fight for freedom by highlighting the numerous actors involved in the fight for liberation; and
2. underscore the various narratives which provide a meaningful way to remember the day-to-day stories of individual who lived and survived the war and the various discourses on the Pacific War which reveal the complexities of this critical juncture in history.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.

The target participants are students and teachers from both public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide.
