The National Book Development Board (NBDB), in partnership with the Philippine Board on Books for Young People (PBBY), will conduct the *Umuulan ng Libro: The Philippine Children's Book Summit* on July 21, 2015 at the Centris Elements Event Center in Quezon City. This is in celebration of the 32nd National Children's Book Day.
