FIRST INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE HISTORICAL ASSOCIATION (PHA)

The Philippine Historical Association (PHA), in partnership with the University of Santo Tomas (UST) (host institution), National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), Philippine Social Science Council (PSSC), Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), and various Asian embassies in the Philippines, will conduct the *First International Conference* with the theme *Historical Education in Asia: Issues and Challenges* from August 27 to 29, 2015 at the UST, España, Manila. This is in commemoration of the 60th Founding Anniversary of PHA, and the National Celebration of History Month by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 339, s. 2012.

The Conference aims to:

1. provide the participants with a venue for discussion on new historical studies, research, writing and teaching methods; and
2. develop their critical deep understanding of new studies and researches on historical education, including strategies and methods in doing research, teaching and propagating historical, cultural and heritage studies.

The specific topics include the following:

1. Trends in Historiography in the 21st Century;
2. Teaching Model in History;
3. Bringing History Closer to the People;
4. Revisiting Curriculum Frameworks;
5. Charting Ground Breaking Paths in Various Institutions; and
6. Texts and History.

The target participants are teachers, scholars, and researchers interested in Historical Education in Asia.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
