GINTONG PARANGAL PARA SA EDUKASYON AWARDEES*

6. must have at least a Bachelor's degree.

The winners will be awarded on *September 25, 2015* at the *Bulwagan ng Karunungan*, DepEd Central Office (CO), DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.
