The Knowledge Community Inc. will hold the *Next Generation of Teachers (Next Gen) Conference 2015* with the theme *Impact and Innovation in Schools Through Information, Communication Technology (ICT) in Education* from October 26 to 28, 2015 at the Foundation University, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental.

The Conference aims to:

1. provide the participants with opportunity to evaluate the impact of more than a decade-long implementation of different ICT in education programs in the Philippines;
