The Philippine Association of English Language, Linguistics, and Literature Teachers (PAELLLT) Inc., and the Philippine Center for Teachers' Continuing Education Inc. will hold the *Fourth National Seminar-Workshop in Teaching English and Literature* with the theme *Traditions, Tensions, Trends, and Transitions in Teaching English and Literature: Meeting Educational Qualification Standards* from December 18 to 20, 2015 at the Institute of Social Order, Ateneo de Manila University, Loyola Heights, Quezon City.
