CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR MUSIC TEACHERS OF THE UNIVERSITY
OF THE PHILIPPINES (UP) COLLEGE OF MUSIC EXTENSION PROGRAM

The University of the Philippines (UP) College of Music Extension Program announces its *Continuing Education for Music Teachers*. Enrolment and classes will start on April 18, 2016.

The Certificate Program aims to:

1. enable the teacher-participants to demonstrate a thorough understanding of the principles of Music theory, practice and pedagogy;
2. train them on how to apply musical and pedagogical knowledge and skills in solo and group rehearsal and performance, and in general, Music classroom experiences; and
3. allow them to show appreciation of Music teaching and learning situations, as well as of diverse forms of Music-making and Music cultures in the Philippines and the world.

The Program is composed of 68 units spread out in three levels over three summers. This year, Levels One, Two and Three of the Certificate Program will be offered. Each level takes one month or four weeks to complete with an average of 6.5 hours of training daily for one month. Completion of each level maybe attained by completing 21-22 units for each summer for full-time students, while part time students may take more than three summers to complete the required units. However, the maximum residency of completing all 68 units is six summers.

There will only be 15-20 slots for each batch of participants per level. Application will be processed on a *first come, first served basis*.

A certificate of program completion will be given by the UP College of Music Extension Program at the end of three levels. There will be no certificate of completion for less than 68 units.

The participants must be teachers who are teaching Music from both public and private schools.
