FIRST PHILTESOL: A REGIONAL ELT CONFERENCE IN TEACHING
AND LEARNING ENGLISH AS A SECOND/FOREIGN LANGUAGE

The Philippine Association of English Language, Linguistics, and Literature Teachers (PAELLLT) Inc., and the Philippine Center for Teachers' Continuing Education (PCTCE) Inc. will hold its *First PhilTESOL: A Regional ELT Conference in Teaching and Learning English as a Second/Foreign Language* with the theme *Traditions, Tensions, Trends, and Transitions in Teaching English for Specific Purposes* from December 2 to 4, 2016 at the Institute of Social Order (ISO), Ateneo de Manila University (AdMU), Loyola Heights, Quezon City.
