2016 MEDIA SUMMIT ON CLIMATE CHANGE AND DISASTER RISK REDUCTION
OF THE ASIA-PACIFIC BROADCASTING UNION (ABU)

The Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union (ABU), in collaboration with the Courseline Training Center and Thai Public Service Broadcasting, will conduct the *2016 Media Summit on Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction* from May 12 to 14, 2016 in Krabi, Thailand.

The Summit aims to:

1. promote disaster risk reduction throughout the education sector for sustainable development;
2. plan for educational continuity in the context of hazards;
3. strengthen a disaster resilient citizenry through education; and
4. develop strategies for education and the media to work together in preparing people for the dramatic effects of climate change and future increased natural hazards.
