LAUNCHING OF THE NATIONAL ANTI-DRUG CAMPAIGN PROGRAM

In support of the Department of Education Memorandum No. 200, s. 2016 entitled *Strengthening the National Drug Education Program in Schools*, a National Anti-Drug Campaign Program will be launched on March 12, 2017 at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC) Grounds, Pasay City.

The Campaign aims to educate schoolchildren regarding the harmful effects of illegal drugs.

The target participants are Grades 3 to 6 pupils from selected public schools in the cities of Parañaque, Pasay, and Manila.
