YOUNG TALENT OPEN RAPID CHAMPIONSHIPS AND CHESS IN EDUCATION  
TRAINING FOR TEACHERS OF THE KASPAROV  
CHESS FOUNDATION ASIA-PACIFIC

The Kasparov Chess Foundation (KCF) Asia-Pacific, in partnership with the National Chess Federation of the Philippines (NCFP), will conduct the *KCF Young Talent Open Rapid Championships* and the *KCF Chess in Education (CIE) Training for Teachers* on March 26 and 27, 2017 at the Alphaland Building, Malugay Street, Makati City.

The two-day activity complements NCFP's grassroots chess development program in schools.

The top three winners will receive trophies and subsidies in the 2017 ASEAN Age-Group Championships in Malaysia amounting to \$250, \$150, and \$100. The 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> placers will also be awarded trophies and all participants will receive certificates of participation signed by chess genius GM Gari Kasparov.

The target participants are teacher-coaches and chess players in the Under 8, Under 10, Under 12, Under 14, and Under 18 age groups from both public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
