#ENDCHILDMARRIAGE NATIONWIDE POSTER-MAKING COMPETITION

The Philippine Legislators' Committee on Population and Development (PLCPD), supported by the Global Affairs Canada, Oxfam, and its partners, will conduct a Nationwide Poster-Making Competition with the theme #EndChildMarriage: Creating Spaces to Empower Young Girls.

The conference aims to:

1. help create spaces for young people to advocate for the rights of women and girls through art,
2. recognize the role of young people in spreading awareness on the prevalence and impact of child marriage on young people's health and development, and
3. encourage them to take action to address the said issue.

Entries must be all-original, unpublished, not previously submitted to other competitions, and hand-drawn using any medium (e.g. watercolor, oil pastel, acrylic, crayons).
