DEPED INTEGRATED SHORT-TERM SCHOLARSHIP
PROGRAM FOR SUMMER 2006

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepED) through the Staff Development Division-Human Resource Development Service (SDD-HRDS) and National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) announces the DepED Integrated Scholarship Program (DISP) for Summer 2006 to be conducted by the University of the Philippines (UP), Diliman, Quezon City from April 17, 2006 to May 12, 2006 (22 contact days). The short-term courses are offered to both elementary and secondary classrooms teachers.
2. The courses aim to upgrade the teaching competencies of teachers to facilitate better understanding of the content and integrative processes on reading (with focus on effective reading instruction, diagnosis and development of reading remediation and science and mathematics teaching (chemistry and physics for secondary).
3. Each course will accommodate 40 scholars. The following scheme shall be observed in the distribution of regional slots:

4. The Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) in each region conducts preliminary screening and submits the names of nominees to the NEAP and SDD-HRDS for the final screening. The participants shall be determined by the NEAP and SDD-HRDS after the final evaluation and interview of the recommended nominees. The deadline for the submission of nominees is January 31, 2006 to the SDD-HRDS, Department of Education, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City at telefax no. 638-8638. Enclosed are the criteria for selection of nominees and pertinent papers for submission to RISC. Accepted participants are expected to submit to the SDD-HRDS duly accomplished CS form 212 with 2"x2" recent photo, certification that the grantee is actually teaching and signed scholarship contract upon their arrival in Manila. They are strictly advised to attend the final day of classes and closing program of the University. The screening of the regional nominees is specified on the following dates and venues:



5. Grantees of the program are entitled to their salaries, free tuition fee, and subsidy of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) for living allowance. Living allowance subsidy will be paid on the last week of the course duration. Travel expenses and per diem of participants are chargeable against local/school funds.

6. Expenses for this DepED Integrated Scholarship Program and selection of scholars which include travel, per diem and allowance, supplies and materials, board and lodging of the Central Office Screening Committee are chargeable against Teacher Scholarship and Fellowship Grants Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF NOMINEES FOR THE SHORT TERM COURSES

1. A bachelor's degree holder related to the area of scholarship nominated to with a grade point average of not lower than 2, B, or 85
2. Has been a permanent teacher for at least three (3) years with a performance rating of very satisfactory (VS) or better. For secondary teachers, knowledge and skills in developing learning/teaching modules is preferred
3. Is actually teaching the subject nominated to and belongs to the school where there is high percentage of non-readers and achievement level is low
4. Not more than 45 years of age
5. Has no pending administrative case and/or criminal record
6. Has been certified by a government physician to be physically and mentally fit
7. Has not availed of any scholarship/training program for the last two (2) years
8. Possesses leadership potential, facilitation skills, positive attitude and commitment
9. Can communicate adequately in English
10. Can develop and implement relevant re-entry projects

PERTINENT PAPERS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE REGIONAL INTEGRATED SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE (RISC)

1. Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet) with a 2"x2" recent photo duly certified by the Administrative Officer
2. Certified photocopy of the transcript of records
3. Form 86 (Health Certificate from accredited government hospital/clinic)
4. Service Record
5. Certification from the principal or from the immediate superior indicating that the nominee is teaching the subject area and recommendation for the scholarship
6. Endorsement from the superintendent
7. Duly accomplished scholarship contract
