DepED MEMORANDUM

FIRST NATIONAL CONGRESS ON PRESCHOOL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary Schools

1. The present government administration in its Ten-Point Agenda has declared a policy calling for the standardization of preschool and day care centers. The Department of Education (DepED) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) in coordination with the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and Portage Association of the Philippines, Inc. (PAPI) for Early Intervention announces the holding of the **First National Congress on Preschool Education** at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 18-20, 2006. The theme of this Congress is "Preschool Education: Start Right, Grow Smart".
2. The Congress aims to provide opportunities for the participants to:
 - a. share new trends and best practices in the education of the preschoolers;
 - b. identify programs and services related to early childhood education;
 - c. share teaching strategies that promote maximum potential among preschool children;
 - d. determine unified curriculum standards for preschool education; and
 - e. strengthen partnership among preschool stakeholders on the institutionalization of preschool education nationwide.
3. Preschool teachers, preschool education administrators/school heads, ECD/preschool division and regional supervisors, chiefs, assistant chiefs of Elementary Education Division, early childhood care and development advocates and other officials/preschool stakeholders in both public and private schools/institutions are invited to attend. Participants from public schools/institutions are authorized to attend on official business while those from private schools/institutions shall make arrangements with their administrators.
4. ***A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover board and lodging for three days, kits/handouts, certificates, honoraria of the resource speakers, supplies and materials and other related expenses incident to this activity. Meals shall be served starting dinner of May 17 until p.m. snacks of May 20. Participants can check in at 3:00 p.m. on May 17, 2006 and check out at 3:00 p.m. on May 20, 2006.***
