CORRIGENDA AND ADDENDA TO DepED MEMORANDUM NO. 197, S. 2006  
(108<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence)

1. Paragraphs 1 and 3 of DepED Memorandum No.197, s. 2006 are hereby corrected to read as follows:

1. The Department of Education (DepED) through the National Historical Institute (NHI) and assisted by the Department of Tourism (DOT) is hereby directed to plan, coordinate, implement and conduct the programs and activities in celebration of the 2006 Independence Day through Memorandum Order No. 217 signed by President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo on May 24, 2006. The theme of this year's celebration is "Pagkakaisa para sa Matatag na Republika".

3. As the Honorary Chairman of the National Organizing Committee (NOC), Secretary Fe A. Hidalgo with DepED officials (National, Regional, and Division) together with teachers and students will participate in the programs and activities listed in the enclosure. These activities will be replicated nationwide in cooperation with the local government units and non-government organizations and associations.

2. These are the addenda to the said Memorandum:

a. The DepED - National Capital Region is requested to send 150 teachers to occupy the North Wing (DepED designated area) of the Quirino Grandstand (Tickets will be given to the NCR Regional Special Events Coordinator, Dr. Noemi M. Bellosillo before June 12, 2006). Likewise DepED-NCR shall send 1,200 fourth and third year students and teachers to occupy the central portion of the grounds fronting the Quirino Grandstand.

b. Regions III and IV-CALABARZON nearby divisions shall send 50 teachers (each region) to be seated at the North Wing with the NCR officials and employees during the affair. (Tickets will be available at the DepED - Special Events Unit, 505 Bonifacio Bldg., DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City). These regions are also

requested to send at least 100 teachers and students to occupy the central portion of the grounds fronting the Quirino Grandstand.

c. All participating audience are requested to be at the designated area two hours before the program:

- i. FLAG-RAISING at the Rizal Monument at 8:00 AM  
 Assembly time : 6:30 AM to 7:00 AM  
 Attire : As appropriate
- ii. PARADE at the Quirino Grandstand at 8:30 AM  
 Assembly time : 6:30 AM to 7:00 AM  
 Attire : As appropriate / Casual
- iii. Reminder: Due to inclement weather, please be advised to bring head cover or an umbrella.
- iv. All DepED officials and employees who shall attend the Flag-Raising Ceremonies and the Kalayaan Parade shall be granted one (1) day service credit.

d. The Department will be represented by the following officials in the following sites on June 12, 2006:

ix. Iloilo City, 7:00 AM - Dir. Victoriano Tirol with Supt. Erlinda G. Gencaya.


