





② Campfire evening party:

Participants are voluntary to put on show.

Roast whole mutton, light fireworks, cook, and lodge in camp (2 person/camp).

2. Visiting famous universities:

To visit Peking University, Tsinghua University, Beijing Normal University and other well-known universities.

3. Tour of places of historic interest and scenic beauty:

To visit the Imperial Palace, the Summer Palace, Great wall and some other places where participants are will go to visit.

4. Lecture:

Prepare to invite the academicians of Chinese Academy of Sciences and universal professor to give lectures.

Content: Confucianism culture or the psychological health of teenagers.

5. Learning Chinese and songs:

To learn simple greetings phrases and songs of each country.

6. Interesting activities:
