POLICY ON THE OPERATIONS OF TEACHERS' CAMP, BAGUIO CITY

All Concerned

1. Pursuant to the desire of the department to preserve and maintain the Baguio Teachers' Camp as a worthy venue for conferences and a rest and recreation destination of our teachers and guests that will provide opportunities for professional growth and development, there is a need to enhance the system of operations of the Camp.
2. Taking into account the Camp's forthcoming Centennial celebration in 2008 which requires extensive preparation and physical rehabilitation, the Camp must be preserved according to its original structure and design since it is considered as a heritage site.
3. Consistent with its mandate as an organizational structure under the Office of the Secretary of the Department, the Director supervising the Camp operations is hereby ordered to report directly to the Office of the Secretary of all its concerns pertaining to the Camp operations.
4. All policy communications and other major matters shall be addressed to the Secretary for proper supervision including granting of requests, addressing of problems, issues and concerns and approval of major expenditures, among others.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
