ENGLISH ENRICHMENT COURSE FOR ALS MOBILE TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors
 Regional Directors
 Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Alternative Learning System (BALS) in coordination with the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) will conduct the **English Enrichment Course for ALS Mobile Teachers** on December 11-15, 2006 at the Development Academy of the Philippines, Tagaytay City. Travel days are December 11 and 15, respectively.

2. In general, the course is expected to help the ALS Mobile Teachers improve in the four components of English such as Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. The course is expected to enhance their skills through various individual and group activities. The course will provide the Mobile Teachers the opportunity to improve their teaching performance and realize better learning outcomes from the ALS learning interventions that they provide.


3. At the end of the four-day course, the participants are expected to:
- obtain further knowledge and skills in Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing the English language;
 - apply the newly acquired knowledge and skills through various group and individual exercises;
 - exhibit confidence in the practice of the written and spoken English language; and
 - appreciate the importance of being competent in the English language in advancing one's professional development.

4. The participants to the said training workshops are the 665 ALS Mobile Teachers. The official number of Mobile Teachers in each region is as follows:

5. Experts on linguistics and the study of spoken and written language will serve as resource persons. Meanwhile, BALS staff will serve as facilitators in the workshops. The Tentative Schedule of Activities is enclosed for reference.
6. Registration starts in the afternoon of December 11, 2006 (Monday) and dinner will be served to the participants. Departure will be after breakfast of December 15 (Friday). Training days are from Tuesday to Thursday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
7. Expenses relative to the conduct of the course such as travel, board and *lodging of all the participants will be charged against 2006 Special Training Fund* for DepED - Pump-Priming Project, through BALS, subject to the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Plane fares of participants were computed based on the discounted airfare deals. They are therefore expected to take the cheapest form of transportation to and from the venue. Transport expenses of the participants will be reimbursed after submitting original and official tickets, receipts and other required travel documents.
