2007 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON HEARING IMPAIRMENT, MENTAL
RETARDATION AND LEARNING DISABILITY

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Department of Education (DepED) in coordination with Christoffel Blindenmission International (CBM) is sponsoring Training Programs for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired, Teachers of Children with Mental Retardation, and Teachers of Children with Learning Disability for Summer 2007. The training programs will be held at designated institutions in the three geographical areas on dates specified:

- Luzon Area** : **Philippine Normal University (PNU)**
Taft Avenue, Manila
April 16 - May 12, 2007
- Visayas Area** : **Cebu Normal University (CNU)**
Osmeña Blvd., Cebu City
April 11 - May 11 , 2007
- Mindanao Area** : **Holy Cross College of Davao City**
Sta. Ana Avenue, Davao City
April 16 - May 12 , 2007

2. The training programs aim to upgrade competencies of teachers in providing educational services to children with hearing impairment, those with mental retardation and those with learning disabilities.

3. Priority participants/nominees shall come from the identified regions/divisions/districts/schools where there is an urgent need for the hearing impaired and those with mental retardation. Teacher nominees for the program on learning disability should preferably come from regular classes. (See *Enclosure Nos. 3A, 3B and 3C*). Applicants for the training programs shall be screened by the Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee based on the criteria set in *Enclosure No.1*. Deadline for submission of nominees to the region is on April 2, 2007. The list of candidates together with the documents listed in *Enclosure No. 1* and the Memorandum of Agreement (Training Contract) duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (See *Enclosure No. 2*) shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education not later than April 9, 2007.

4. Teachers trained in the 2006 Summer Training Programs on Hearing Impairment and Mental Retardation at the Philippine Normal University, Manila, Cebu Normal University, Cebu City and Holy Cross College of Davao City, Davao City who have provided educational services to the hearing impaired and the mentally retarded are considered for the second summer training in 2007. Their names are listed in *Enclosure Nos. 4A and 4B* respectively.

5. All grantees are entitled to benefits and privileges indicated in *Enclosure No. 1*. Travel expenses to and from the venue shall be borne by the sponsoring agency. Likewise, participants to these training programs are advised to travel by sea or land. New participants are advised to be in school before the actual schedule of classes for the entrance examination and other requirements.

6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with the required documents. Expenses for the training shall be charged to their agency funds.

TRAINING PROGRAMS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION**

1. A Bachelor's degree holder for the elementary level
2. **Actually teaching regular or SPED classes** without training at the elementary
3. Grade point average of 2.0/85 in the undergraduate/graduate/post graduate study
4. Is not more than 45 years old
5. If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother
6. Has no administrative/criminal record.
7. Physically fit, mentally healthy and register positive attitude and commitment towards work, peers and students
8. Willing to conduct and/or assist in service training activities after scholarship
9. Willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses
10. Not under a scholarship program for the past three (3) years.
11. Communicative in both English and Filipino.

**PERTINENT PAPERS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE
REGIONAL SPED SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE**

1. Duly Accomplished Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet)
2. A Very Satisfactory Performance Appraisal Rating for the past three (3) rating periods
3. Certified true copy of Transcript of Records
4. Form 86 (Health Certificate)
5. Certification from Head Office (Principal/Superintendent/Chief of Elementary Education/Secondary Education Division) that the nominee is actually teaching and recommendation for scholarship duly endorsed by the Superintendent and Regional Director.
6. Duly accomplished Training Contract

5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her functions upon the completion or termination of his/her training;
6. Organize SPED programs or classes for the hearing impaired, mentally retarded and learning disabled;
7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two years after each summer training.
8. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to the Christoffel Blindenmission International sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine Government and/or sponsor if he/she fails to provide educational services to the hearing impaired, mentally retarded and learning disabled for two years after each summer training; and
9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
