2007 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAM ON VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Chairman, CHED

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) and the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) in coordination with the Philippine Normal University (PNU), Cebu Normal University (CNU) and the University of Southeastern Philippines (USP), Davao City will conduct the 2007 Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired at the training venues and dates found below:

Luzon Area	:	Philippine Normal University (PNU) Taft Avenue, Manila April 10 – May 5, 2007
Visayas Area	:	Cebu Normal University (CNU) Cebu City April 10 – May 5, 2007
Mindanao Area	:	University of Southeastern Philippines (USP) Davao City April 10 – May 5, 2007

2. The training program, sponsored by the Resources for the Blind, Inc., aims to enhance competencies of teachers in providing educational services to visually impaired children in regular and special schools.

3. Participants to the training will come from the identified regions/divisions/districts/schools where there is an urgent need for teachers for the visually impaired (Enclosure No. 1). The Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) shall screen the nominees based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 2. Enclosure No. 3 is the Memorandum of Agreement or the Training Contract. Deadline for the submission of nominees is set on March 23, 2007. The nominees are advised to make a collect call to Mr. Randy Weisser, Director, Resources for the Blind Inc. at tel. no. (02) 726-30-21 for interview in March 2007. The RISC shall submit the final list of nominees and the required documents to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education on or before April 2, 2007.

4. Only those teachers who are actually providing services to the visually impaired students will be given the opportunity to continue the training program this Summer 2007. (Enclosure No. 4).

5. All grantees shall be entitled to free tuition fees and a month's stipend. Grantees from all Regions under the training program at the PNU will receive a month's stipend of Two Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP2,400.00) while those

from NCR, Cebu City and Davao City shall receive One Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP1,400.00). All grantees are advised to travel by land or sea. Travel expenses shall be borne by the sponsoring agency.

6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the Special Education Division, BEE, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with the required documents at tel. no. (02) 631-99-93.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

3. Has a grade point average of 2.0/85 in the undergraduate/graduate/post graduate study.
4. Is not more than 45 years.
5. If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother.
6. Has no administrative/criminal record.
7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and register positive attitude and commitment towards work, peers and students.
8. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses.
9. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years.
10. Can adequately communicate in both English and Filipino.
